Second Sunday of Advent
Be Reformed

Ever since the time of our Baptism, in some way, our faith has been **formed**. We learned our prayers. And, in Faith Formation classes, we learned about Jesus Our Lord and His Gospel Message of love and holiness. We also continued to learn about the teachings and traditions of our Church as recorded in the Bible and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. We learned about the Sacraments of the Church and that we receive the three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. Even today, we are constantly **BEING FORMED** in our faith.

There is a time in all of us when we may question aspects of our faith, doubt our belief in God, blame God for causing illness, think that God will not forgive us, get used to not praying and not attending Mass as regularly as before. Or, we may simply be struggling silently in our faith against the temptations of discouragement, selfishness, and worry. It is in these moments that John the Baptist's words in our Gospel Reading today speak to us directly to "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." (Matthew 3: 2)


In other words, we have been **formed** in our faith. Now it is time to recall what we have learned and go further in our faith and love for God to **Be Reformed**.

- † Go to Confession. Saturdays at 4:45 pm or attend our Advent Penance Service on Sunday, December 21st at 2:00 pm.
- † Read daily the Little Blue Book for Advent
- † Attend Sunday Mass
- † Come to Adoration and Benediction on Sunday evenings at 6:00 pm.

My hope is for all of us that in the midst of the busyness and stressfulness of this time of the year, that doing the above and just sitting quietly and still, while in thought and prayer, can bring peace to all of us.

THE ADVENT WREATH A very important symbol that is set up in the Sanctuary during the Advent Season is the Advent Wreath. The four candles, set on a circular frame and surrounded by evergreens, symbolize our waiting for the Light of Christ to come into our shadowed, sinful world.

We light the first candle at the end of the Universal Prayers on the First Sunday of Advent, when we pronounce a blessing on the candles. We will light the other candles, before the Opening Prayer, for the next three Sundays of the Season of Advent. The purple candles symbolize our anticipation of Christ's Light to shine even brighter in our own lives, so we can be ready for His Coming to us at Christmas. The rose candle symbolizes joy. You can also make your own Advent Wreath for your home.

May each of us strive to receive and have a greater joy during this Advent Season as we prepare for a joyous Christmas to come!


